



PLEASE HELP SAVE OUR HORSES!

H.R. 1661 The SAFE ACT of 2026 as drafted and introduced to protect our dogs, cats and horses from slaughter needs two 'perfecting amendments' first before passage.

What we have now is half a bill with two major one word loopholes.

- First the word 'human' needs to be deleted from human consumption thereby prohibiting the slaughter for both human & pet foods among other uses. Otherwise horses will just be exported for Mexico's 8 billion dollar a year worldwide pet food industry.
- And second the word 'intra' needs to be added to interstate and foreign commerce to also prohibit slaughter within states for custom no inspection slaughter houses.

And without the addition of 'intra' to interstate and foreign commerce prohibitions, the bill will not pass the Dormant Commerce Clause balancing test and can be overturned if challenged.

Also not part of the text of the bill but below in the glossary definition of Equine was changed to include only 'Horses and Mules' when it should read: Horses, Ponies, Mules and Donkeys especially donkeys which were removed as they are a species needing protection against Amazon today.

CALL TO ACTION: delete 'human' from consumption; add 'intra' to interstate & foreign commerce and add donkey to equine definition.

Banning the Slaughter of America's Horses is an issue that 83% of Likely Voters have supported for over 30 years. State Laws have been enacted in California, Texas, Illinois, New Jersey and New York. A Horse Bill has passed the House twice and continues to sit with 224 co-sponsors with bi-partisan support for the last three years.
